

PARENT / GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

As a Parent / Guardian of a RAGE player, I will...

- Support the coaches, the players, and the team by not coaching from the sidelines.
- Acknowledge and applaud the genuine effort of all players – both team members and opponents.
- Engage courteously and respectfully with coaches, referees, and other parents, including those of the opposing team.
- Refrain from boasting about my player's accomplishments but rather applaud any player that demonstrates characteristics of integrity, empathy, sacrifice, and responsibility.
- Affirm and applaud players not just for athletic performance or victory, but whenever good character, healthy sportsmanship, and unselfish behavior are displayed.
- Support the team regardless of the win/loss record and encourage players with positive statements, even when they make mistakes.
- Serve as a role model of good sportsmanship by accepting defeat graciously, and teaching and encouraging my player to do the same.
- Acknowledge and appreciate all players' growth toward maturity and their effort toward establishing stronger relationships with teammates, coaches, and themselves.
- Recognize that at every practice players are growing physically and emotionally, are learning moral and ethical lessons, and are developing character.
- Encourage my player to work directly with the coach to resolve issues, thereby helping her develop a strong sense of self-advocacy.
- Escalate to the Director of Coaching only when sincere issue resolution attempts are not successful at the team level.

Because I am a parent / guardian with the power and platform to make a positive difference in the life of every player, I commit to this code of conduct. I take full responsibility for my actions and understand that disciplinary action taken by the club is a possible consequence of misconduct.
