DOC: Erin Sharpe

- ECNL Phoenix Event: 4 of 5 teams picked up points. There was great college coach exposure for the players. Maylen Montoya was selected for a second time (which is rare) to play in the National Selection Game and scored.
- Tryout logistics finalized and pushed out.
- 24-25 Comp coaching slate finalized and pushed out.
- Team seasonal plans will be pushed out upon approval of budget.
- New coaches are getting in front of players before try-outs.
- New coach from Mustang: Brandon Kearney. Will coach 2011 ECNL-RL and be Co-Fitness Director with Jonathan Decker as we move fitness programming in-house
- Congrats to new college commit: Azariya Smith (Southern University). Many more regularly taking visits and in discussions with schools now. There are a lot of offers on the tables for our players. Will be exciting to see where they commit.

- CJ reviewed the Financial YOY Performance Summary and Budget vs Actual Summary with the Board.
- Operational Updates:
 - Bookkeeper relocating to San Diego
 - Discussed Pleasanton Youth Soccer League tax returns. It needs to be determined if RAGE or Ballistic is to complete the forms.
 - BOD approved \$10,000 marketing resource spend in current soccer year. (Eric motioned, Vishakha seconded). Motion was approved.
- Discussed Interpretation of Bylaw 3:01:02
- V0.9 24/25 Budget was distributed to Board on April 7th.

Facilities: Ryan Callahan

- Ryan gave a general update on seeking potential sites for new RAGE offices and facilities.
 - Ball is still in RAGE's court to create a fundraising plan to generate funds for a potential site.
- Pleasanton Middle School field project:
 - Three futsal courts similar to what is existing
 - Two of three grass 7 v 7 or 9 v 9 fields
 - One 11 v 11 turf field
 - Have not received an update from PUSD for about 5 weeks.
- Conditions of existing grass fields at Aquatic Park:
 - Hearing complaints from parents on height of grass
 - Discussed whether RAGE or BUSC can do anything about it. Requests were put into the city but a burst pipe impacted mowings and they are not willing to cut the grass shorter at this time.
