Fielded Players	11 per team (10 field players + goalkeeper)
Field Size	70 x 115 yards, approximate 50 yds min. / 80 yds. Max. x 100 yds. Min. / 120 yds. max.
Ball Size	5
Game Duration	U14: Two 35 minute halves = 70 minutes U16: Two 40 minute halves = 80 minutes Half-Time: 10 minutes U19: Two 45 minute halves = 90 minutes
Overtime	No overtime; Rules are subject to change in tournament play.
Referees	East Bay Referee Association (EBRA) supplied.
Substitution	Unlimited substitutions at any stoppage of play.
Throw-in	Yes
Goal Kick	Yes
Corner Kick	Yes
Indirect Free Kick	Awarded for an Indirect Kick Offense. Ball must be touched by a second player for a goal to be scored.
Direct Free Kick	Awarded for a Direct Kick Offense. A goal may be scored directly from this kick.
Penalty Kick	Awarded when a Direct Kick Offense is committed by a player in their own penalty area.
Fouls/Misconduct	FIFA Law 12 – Fouls and Misconduct  Direct Kick Offenses:  Kicks or attempts to kick an opponent Trips or attempts to trip an opponent Jumps at an opponent Charges opponent Strikes or attempts to strike an opponent Tackles an opponent Tackles an opponent Tackles an opponent Tackles an opponent Mandball Offence Except the goalkeeper within her own penalty area)  Indirect Kick Offenses: Goalkeeper, inside her own penalty area:  Controls ball with hands more than 6 seconds before releasing it Touches ball with hands after releasing it & before it has touched another player Touches the ball with hands after it has been deliberately kicked to her by a teammate Touches the ball with hands directly from a throw-in taken by a teammate  Touches the ball with hands directly from a throw-in taken by a teammate  Any player on the field: Plays in dangerous manner Impedes the progress of an opponent Prevents the goalkeeper from releasing the ball Commits any other offense for which play is stopped to caution or send off a player  Cards -

	Yellow: Signifies that a player has a received a formal caution. If a player receives 2 yellow cards in one game then they shall be ejected from the game.  Red: Signifies that a player has been ejected from the game.
Offside	Indirect Free Kick Offence Fifa Law 11 - Offside
Pass to Goalie	Indirect Free Kick Offence FIFA Law 12 – Fouls and Misconduct (Offenses by Goalkeepers – p.24) The goalkeeper cannot touch the ball with her hands directly after it hasbeen deliberately kicked or thrown-in to her by a teammate.
Playing Time	Every player must see equal amount of playing time, unless player is injured or sick. Playing time may be affected by Yellow or Red cards.
Bleeding	Player must leave the field of play until bleeding has stopped or is contained in a way that reasonably eliminates possibility of blood exposure to other players.
Jewelry	No jewelry allowed. Earrings and other piercings cannot be taped over.  Medic alert bracelets excepted.
Spectators	Must sit/stand on the opposite side of the field from players. Cannot sit/stand behind goal lines. Must not coach players from the sideline. Are encouraged to give positive feedback to all players.
Mercy Rule	Players on a team with a <b>4 goal lead</b> must be encouraged to utilize their non-dominant foot and make a specified number (as determined by the coach) of passes, moves, and/or touches on the ball before going to goal.
League Standings	Standings are maintained to determine a League Champion.
