TRI-VALLEY FUTSAL CENTER



We imagine many of you have heard of the new 3 court futsal facility coming to the Alameda County Fairgrounds in Pleasanton, and we are thrilled to share that the Tri-Valley Futsal Center is finally coming to fruition! This facility will add value to our programming, and give our players additional access to a dynamic, fast-paced environment that we trust will enhance their technical skills and love for the game.



The Tri-Valley Futsal Center is a premier, outdoor futsal facility serving the East Bay and designed for all ages to play the fast-paced and skill-driven game of futsal. The center features high-quality courts with professional-grade flooring and boundary walls that comply to international futsal standards. Additional amenities include multiple courts, a pro shop, a café, restrooms, and social gathering areas.

NEW AGE GROUP ALIGNMENT 2026/2027



Beginning in the 2026-2027 season, U.S. Soccer is moving from birth year team formations to those that more closely align with the traditional school year. Instead of grouping players strictly by calendar birth year, age groups will use an August 1 – July 31 window so more players compete alongside their school classmates. Pleasanton RAGE is working to ensure this transition is as smooth as possible. This table shows the new age brackets and the typical grade level of players in the 2026-2027 season. Tryouts will take place in May 2026 (see dates on the *Mark Your Calendar* slide).

RAGE SCHOLARSHIP 2026



Purpose: To recognize and reward scholar-athletes who demonstrate RAGE excellence in academic achievement and service to the community.

Scholarships: At least two \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded. Additional scholarships may be awarded based on available funds.
